Admission to Graduate Study as a Graduate Regular

Successful admission to Graduate Study requires admission to a specific graduate degree program. Please indicate your intended graduate degree program on the reverse side. To complete the application process, please submit the following to the UWSP Admissions Office:

1. A completed "Application for Admission to Graduate Study."
2. The \$56 application fee in the form of a check or money order made payable to UW-Stevens Point.
3. **OFFICIAL** transcripts from all colleges (both undergraduate and graduate) you attended (**except UW-Stevens Point**).
 - The transcript from the college from which you graduated must indicate that you earned a bachelor's degree.
 - Transcripts must be sent in a sealed university envelope directly from the college to the UW-Stevens Point Admissions Office, 102 Student Services Building, UWSP, Stevens Point, WI, 54481-3897. Transcripts "issued to the student" are not acceptable.

NOTE: Many of our graduate degree programs require additional criteria such as letters of reference, personal interviews, standardized test scores, verification of certification, etc. We will send your application materials to the graduate program coordinator of the graduate program area you designate on the reverse side of this application as soon as we receive all of the materials indicated in 1-3 above. The graduate program coordinator will then contact you for any additional materials needed to determine your eligibility for admission into the graduate program.

Graduate Special

Graduate special students are not required to complete and submit an application for Graduate Study.

If you hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university or an advanced degree, but you do not wish to be admitted to a graduate degree program, we will give you graduate special status. This category allows you to enroll in graduate-level courses and receive graduate credit for teacher's certification requirements or personal enrichment. If, as a graduate special student, you later wish to be admitted to a degree program, you must complete all of the formal requirements for admission required of those seeking admission to that graduate degree program. A maximum of nine credits earned as a graduate special can apply toward a master's degree (provided they are approved by your adviser and fit within the seven-year time limit). If you decide to pursue a master's degree, it is in your best interest to change your status to graduate regular as soon as possible.
