Five-Tool Camps

For the ballplayer looking to improve in all aspects of the game, we recommend to you our Five-Tool Camp. Focus is provided on each of the 'Five Tools' that we feel are most important in the game of baseball: 1) throwing/pitching, 2) hitting, 3) fielding, 4) baserunning, and 5) mental/physical training. Offered in late December, these camps make a great gift, as we can help teach your ballplayer better baseball habits and techniques that he can carry over into the New Year.



Hitting Camps

Held each Sunday during the month of February, our Hitting Camp provides ballplayers an opportunity to spend four weeks learning how to hit the Pointer Way. Based on rotational hitting philosophy, we instruct and introduce drills that will help each hitter understand the absolutes of the stance, load, stride, and swing path. You must provide your own bat for camp.



Pitcher/Catcher Camp

Campers looking to get their arms in shape for the upcoming season should consider our Pitcher/Catcher Camp, held the first two Sundays during the month of March. Both pitchers and catchers will be able to fine-tune their mechanics and will benefit from the participation of one another at camp. Emphasis will be placed on developing repeatable throwing mechanics through a series of drills and simulated bullpen sessions. Catchers will receive instruction on framing, blocking, and pitch sequencing as well. Each camper will receive a written evaluation at the end of camp.

REGISTRATION POLICIES & PROCEDURES (please read)

You must pre-register your son at least 1 week prior to the start of camp to guarantee him a spot. All camps require a non-refundable deposit of 50% of the camp fee to hold a spot for the camper. The remaining 50% of the fee is due the first day of camp—full payment is accepted at any time. Cancellation notices received prior to the start of camp will receive a full refund—cancellations during camp will receive a prorated refund minus a \$50 cancellation fee. No refunds will be given for no-shows. We thank you for your cooperation.

Hitting & Pitching/Catching Academy

For the player who wants to continue to improve year-round, we offer our Academies as a means to continue improving in the game when many others have put their bats and gloves away for the season. Each Academy will last for six weeks with one 2-hour session per week. This two-hour block provides ample time to teach the critical aspects of hitting, pitching, & catching—with six opportunities for our staff to assess and evaluate your progress.

And because we want to emphasize one-on-one instruction as much as possible, we have capped the number of campers who can attend.

Prospect Camps

We offer our Prospect Camps as a means for high-school ballplayers to learn the most

advanced aspects of the game so that they can utilize their increasing physical and mental maturity to take their game to the next level. This is not an exclusive or 'select' camp—anyone who wants to receive more technical knowledge about all aspects of the game is welcome at our Prospect Camps. Part of the camp will be devoted to collecting objective data (speed, agility, arm strength) that will help us in providing you will subjective analysis and information that you can use to make yourself better. We will include this data and our subjective feedback in an evaluation that you will receive at the end of camp.

- 1) Fill out the attached registration form, remove it from the brochure, and mail it (along with the camp deposit/fee) to the address listed on the back of the brochure.
- 2) Upon receipt of your registration, we will send back a confirmatory mailing which will include necessary medial & insurance information—we must have this in hand for your son to attend.
