Satisfactory Progress (Admission Requirements & Academic Standards are listed in the UWSP Catalog)

- 1.) You must have a 2.50 cumulative in-major GPA including courses that transferred into the major.
- 2.) By the time you have completed 18 in-major credits, you must have at least a 2.50 in-major GPA.
- 3.) If you have not earned a 2.50 in-major GPA by the time you have earned 18 major credits, you will be dropped.
- 4.) You can be dropped if your in-major GPA is low for two consecutive semesters, after earning 18 major credits.
