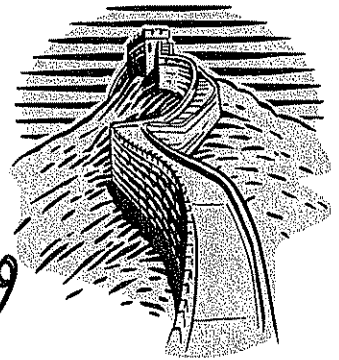


Business & Economics: China

International Internship May 25 ~ June 26, 2009



In conjunction with the Sichuan University in Chengdu, China, the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, Division of Business and Economics and the International Programs Office offer a study abroad program focusing on Business Administration/Economics Internship Experience in China.

There are many reasons to study in China with UWSP, these include:

- ⇒ **Huge market:** due to China's fast economic growth over the last two decades and its recent accession to the World Trade Organization, this transition economy has become one of the largest open markets in the world. Future professional opportunities for those of you who have first-hand experience in China are envisioned.
- ⇒ **Unique educational experiences:** the group will be paired with Chinese business students (who speaks English) to work in Chinese business firms. You will also have additional lectures delivered in English by a Chinese professor. You will also earn 3 credits!
- ⇒ **Better candidacy:** your internship experience should make you a more competitive candidate for firms doing business with China and the Pacific Rim.
- ⇒ **Entry tour to Beijing:** it allows you to see the beauty of one of the oldest capital cities in the world along with sightseeing in and around Chengdu, a city rich in historical and cultural wonders

PROGRAM LEADER: Dr. Gary Mullins is leading the 2009 trip. Dr. Mullins has been teaching business courses at UW-SP for numerous years and also serves as the internship coordinator. Dr. Mullins co-founded the China Business Internship Program in 2002 with Dr. Wang, and has led the trip a number of times in the past.

COST: \$5550-6050 (tentative and based on 15 participants) This includes airfare (Chicago-Beijing-Chengdu/Chengdu-Beijing-Chicago), lectures, accommodation in Chengdu and in Beijing (four star hotel in Beijing!), most meals, in country transportation, guides, receptions, mandated UW-System health insurance, China visa, 3 Wisconsin resident undergraduate credits.

Your Financial Aid applies!

CREDITS: Participants who are majoring/minoring in Business Administration, Economics, or Managerial Accounting choose to enroll for three credits of **Business 493: Internship in China**, or **Economics 493: Internship in China** with a credit and an audit option – both at the same charge. Division majors/minors who have made substantial progress toward graduation in these fields, are given priority for acceptance. Special consideration will be given to non-majors/minors who have had significant coursework in this area. Non-majors/minors will enroll for three credits of **Business 293: Internship in China**. All three courses also count as Non-Western studies GDR credit!

APPLICATION: Request an application form from the International Programs Office. Return the form to International Programs with a \$250 (nonrefundable) deposit **BEFORE** February 15. **Enrollment is limited:** late applications may be considered if there is room available; check with International Programs. An acceptance letter and a Payment Schedule will be sent to you. All deposits are returned if the program is full or if an applicant does not meet the program qualifications.

WITHDRAWAL: Up to ten weeks before the start of the program, all fees except the initial \$250 deposit will be refunded. After that time, tuition, airline, tour costs and housing cancellation charges are assessed. If the program should be canceled, all fees would be refunded. Because exchange rates and airline prices fluctuate, International Programs reserves the right to cancel, surcharge, or to alter the program.
