

# ***Spring Coed Sand V-ball Tournament Information***

***Friday May 1<sup>st</sup> 2:00PM Allen Center***  
***COST: FREE***

**Eligibility:** Only students enrolled at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point may participate in the coed sand volleyball tournament.

**Location:** We will use the three sand volleyball courts on the north side of the Allen Center. ***Check-in, shirt distribution, informational table, and free food and beverages will be located near the volleyball courts.***

**How to Enter:** Submit completed entry form by Monday April 27<sup>th</sup> @ noon to the Student Health Promotion Office, 004 lower Allen Center. ***The first twelve teams to return a completed team roster form will be allowed to participate. The first eight team to return a completed roster form will receive free shirts.***

## **Entry Forms/Waiver:**

1. Team rosters may have six players with a minimum of four players on the court during play. All teams must have at least two males and two females.
2. Each team must have a team captain. The team captain will serve as the official contact for the team. Team captains will provide team members with rules of the tournament, and the time and place of their next game
3. Every member of your team must complete and sign the waiver form, or your team will not be permitted to play.
4. Changes can be made to your roster until Friday May 1<sup>st</sup> at noon. No further changes will be allowed after that date and time. All changes must be made in person at the Student Health Promotion Office.
5. Students may only be listed on one roster and play for one team.
6. You **MUST** include a team name which will identify your team on the tournament schedule. Team names which are not consistent with the volleyball theme and Student Health Promotion mission statement will not be accepted.

## **General Rules:**

1. Sand Volleyball is self officiated.
2. Double elimination tournament. All teams will play ***at least*** two games.
3. A court supervisor will keep the score and time and conduct a coin toss to decide who serves first.
4. Teams must have at least four players on the court during play.
5. The Student Health Promotion staff reserves the right to make decisions on any matters or questions not specifically covered in the rules.

**Forfeit Time: *FORFEIT TIME IS GAME TIME*** a forfeit is given to teams having less than four players at game time or teams that are not ready for play at game time.

**Game Rules:**

1. Each round will consist of **ONE** game to 25 points (side-out scoring) or a 25 minute time limit, whichever comes first. The court supervisors will call the game after the 25 minute time limit. At that time the team with the highest score wins.
2. The court supervisor will flip a coin to determine which team serves first.
3. There are no restrictions regarding court positioning. Any player may play any position within the court at any time.
4. There will only be 5 minutes between games.
5. Server must be behind the back court line. Serves can be overhand or underhand.
6. No attacking/blocking the serve. You must bump or set the ball when receiving a serve.
7. Any contact with the net at any time will be a violation. Double net violation on both teams will result in players replaying the point.
8. Teams must call their own lines and are on the honor system. If two teams cannot agree on a call, the court supervisor will make a decision.

**Check-In:** Team captains must check-in between 1:15-1:45 on May 1<sup>st</sup>. At that time you will receive your teams' free shirts.

**Tournament Schedule:** Tournament schedule will be updated after each round of games. Your team will be identified by their team name.

**Prizes:** Free food, beverages, t-shirts (first 8 teams to register) and door prizes will be given out at the completion of the tournament. Individuals must be present to win door prizes.

**RAIN OR SHINE** we will play volleyball. If by chance it rains (or is extremely windy), the food, beverages, informational table, and check-in area will all be in the lower Allen center hallway. **In the case of thunderstorms/lighting we will have to cancel the tournament.**

*We strongly encourage participants to socialize while other games are in play. Participants will be able to enjoy music, free food, and free beverages.*
