Parking @ UCLCC

When dropping off/picking up your children the ONLY two spots reserved for the Children's Center are the first two spaces immediately following the handicap spot. All other parking spaces in Lot Z are PERMIT ONLY parking spaces and if you are parked in those spaces (even with flashers on) you can/will be ticketed. If the two Children's Center spaces are in use, please use the metered spaces or you may park along the west side of Fremont St. (nearest the Delzell building sidewalk). Thank you!

Valentine's Day Policy

The HRG-UCLCC encourages families **NOT** to send valentines from home for friends at school. The nature of our program does not work well with things being brought from home. Our themes around the Valentine holiday promote friendship. We will make valentines at school instead of bringing from home. Thank you.

<u>Elevator Reminder</u>

Please be certain that you and your children are <u>NOT</u> pressing the alarm button in the elevator when coming/leaving the UCLCC. Each time the button is pressed Security Services is required to respond and in the past couple weeks we have had multiple incidents of the button being pressed.

Parent Reminders

- 1. Billing is done monthly. Statements are found in your mailbox. The bill is due within 10 days of the invoice date. A deposit box for checks is by the sign-in computer. Make checks payable to HRG-UCLCC.
- 2. We go outside daily (weather permitting). Please make sure that your child has snow pants, hats, mittens, boots (winter and rain boots), and a warm jacket. All items should be labeled!
- **3.** Be sure to sign you child in/out daily and take home all correspondence left in your family mailbox.
- 4. Please check your child's cubby for artwork and any extra items and take home daily.
- 5. When your child borrows clothes from the HRG-UCLCC, please return them. Make sure your child always has extra sets of clothes in their cubby.
- 6. The center is licensed for care ONLY between the hours of 7:30am-5:30pm. Please make sure you are not dropping your child off any earlier than this time and that you have arrived at the center, gotten your children, and signed out by 5:30pm. Children may not be signed out prior to your picking them up from their classroom as they are still in our care.
- 7. Special items from home are to remain at home. Please do not allow your child to bring any items from home to their classroom or cubby unless a teacher notifies families otherwise.

4-K Registration for In and Out of District 2024-25

All children that will turn 4 years old before September 1, 2024 are eligible to register for the Stevens Point Area School District 4K program. 4K class is held at the HRG-UCLCC <u>Monday – Thursday, AM session</u> (start time 8:35am with pick up at 11:45am). *Times subject to change per District*. Please check to see if you are eligible according to the following criteria:

- 1. You live in the Stevens Point School District area
- 2. You live in any Wisconsin school district that has a 4-K program

4K Open House for the 2024-2025 School Year will be February 8, from 4:00pm-6:00pm. During Open House, parents/guardians were invited to tour the various 4K locations to see the classroom space and briefly meet the teacher.

Families that live **within the Stevens Point School District** will be able to register for Four Year Old Kindergarten (4K) between the following dates (**this is priority registration, so REGISTER EARLY!!!**):

February 19th (starting at 8 am) – February 23rd

If a family has no computer or internet access, accommodations will be made at the BLISS Educational Services Center during the week of February 19-23, 2024. Families that live **<u>outside of the Stevens Point School District area</u>**, open enrollment will be from **February 5 - April 30, 2024 (you must enroll during this timeframe)**

NO forms will be accepted before or after these dates.

Families Helpful Tips Corner

UCLCC School Rule – BE SAFE

One of our 3 school rules here at the UCLCC is BE SAFE. Being safe can be applied to multiple situations. Below is how we are incorporating the acronym "SAFE" when transitions occur at the center. This can also be applied to when you are dropping off & picking up your children.

Is your child being safe? Are they within your sight? What are your expectations for them?

Be Safe for Every Transitions

S- Stop: Take a pause

A- Address Expectations: Tell the children what will be happening during the transition, and what they should do. Example: We are headed to the bathroom. You will use walking feet, and follow me.

F- Face to Name: Use the safe-keepers to identify who will be going with you. Make sure you have the correct children and the correct number of children.

E- Exit: Now you can transition

*If at any point during the transition there is an interruption, please start over from the beginning. Interruptions can include but are not limited to: a parent dropping off a child or picking up a child, an injury, disagreement between children....
