Weather Reminder

Important Safety Reminders

<u>Gates</u> – All gates throughout the center (hallway and bathroom area) should be closed at all times as well as the kitchen door. If you open any of these, please be sure you are closing them behind you.

<u>Fobs</u> – Family mailbox area is an adult only touch (as we tell the children). Please do not allow your children access to this area. To ensure your fob scan is completely properly, adults should be the only people

scanning the fobs.

Elevator buttons – Adults are only to press elevator buttons. This is something our staff teach the children. Be certain you and your children are NOT pressing the alarm button in the elevator. Each time the button is pressed, Security Services is required to respond.
