Schmeeckle Reserve Student Trails and Facilities Crew Leader

Description:

Schmeeckle Reserve is a 280-acre conservancy area on the campus of UW-Stevens Point. It is a field station of the College of Natural Resources and is open for public use. The mission of the Reserve is to protect, manage, and restore native ecological communities of central Wisconsin, serve as an outdoor classroom for learning, and provide recreational opportunities for the community. The Reserve is heavily used by students, faculty, staff, community residents, and out-of-town visitors. Over 5 miles of maintained trails and boardwalks provide access to the natural area. Facilities include a public visitor center, amphitheater, picnic shelter, and trailhead restroom building.

This paid student supervisory position is integral to the Schmeeckle management team, responsible for coordinating daily trail work and facility maintenance to meet the expectations of the Reserve's stakeholders and users. It provides valuable experience in supervising a work crew, developing and implementing project plans, and working toward goals that enhance the Reserve for both natural and human communities.

Duties:

- Interview, hire, schedule, and supervise a crew of 5-10 student maintenance staff members each semester.
- Develop work plans for maintenance staff to complete daily tasks and projects in an efficient manner.
- Research, plan, and implement new development projects including trails, boardwalks, bridges, benches, signs, and landscaping.
- Coordinate trail maintenance activities including trail resurfacing and repairs, boardwalk/bench repairs, hazardous tree removal, brush removal, water mitigation.
- Coordinate landscaping/land management activities including grass mowing, sign restoration, habitat restoration, invasive species removal, and prescribed burns.
- Coordinate facility maintenance activities including cleaning, painting, repairs, and renovations.
- Supervise the construction of handcrafted wooden signs and benches, a revenue-generating operation that supports the Reserve's annual budget.
- Participate in weekly supervisor meetings.
- Other duties as assigned by the Schmeeckle Reserve director.

- Undergraduate student at UW-Stevens Point.
- Strong work ethic and ability to work independently.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Comfortable speaking to and engaging the public and decision makers.
- Ability to work outside in all types of weather and temperatures.
- Good driving record (driving university vehicles is a required in this position).
