² Responsibility for developing and maintaining Private funding for WEEB was transferred to WEEF in 2006. WEEF is connected to WEEB as follows: 1) WEEB elects the WEEF directors, 2) WEEB chair is an automatic director, 3) WEEB is the registered agent and office for WEEF, and 4) WEEF is required to report annually to WEEB. Details of the WEEF budget are in the annual WEEF report, and are not included in this table.

³ The UW System request for an increase in general EE support for the 2009-11 biennium was not included in the Governor's Feb 17-09 budget proposal. This request included 1) reinstatement of the GPR \$200,000 lost in the 2001-2003 budget cycle, deferred previously for lack of support; 2) increase in FTE and funds for the WEEB admininstrative position and support.

⁴ GPR administrative support is the major source of funding for the WEEB administrative specialist position. The legislative goal is for a long overdue increase in the 0.5 FTE GPR position established in the 1989 WEEB formation legislation (statute 36.54/History: 1989 a. 299, section 12; statute 15.915 (6)) to 1 FTE as soon as feasible.

⁵ Environmental surcharge (statute 299.93) /assessment (statute 20.285(1)(r)) funds are posted at the very end of the previous fiscal year, are awarded during the fiscal year under which they are listed in the chart, and typically spent in the next fiscal year. A bill was drafted in 2004 by then Representative Mark Miller to increase the surcharge from 10% to 20%; was formally introduced (2007 AB 956) by Representative Louis Molepske with Senator Fred Risser as cosponsor in 2008; and was ultimately passed as a budget amendment from Representative Pedro Colon in 2009, with eventually 70% of the 20% surcharge being assigned to WEEB.

⁶ Other includes solicited contributions from DPI, DNR for administrative postion/support (\$22,000, 05-08; \$6000, 09); Justice Department Discretionary Fund (\$10,000, 06-07); private donations; and WEEF (\$425, 07-08; \$1000, 08-09).
