## Wisconsin Comprehensive Planning Law and the Plan Commission

This program provides a brief overview of the Wisconsin Comprehensive Planning Law but focuses on the creation and responsibilities of the plan commission, responsibilities of plan commissioners as local officials and duties of the plan commission under the Open Meetings Law. This program will provide a great base of information for both new and existing municipal plan commission members.

## Public Participation in the Planning Process

## Implementing the Plan

This workshop will discuss plan implementation as a key element of the comprehensive plan.
