David Fodroczi, St. Croix Planning Department, will provide some examples of how municipalities and County government address zoning issues.

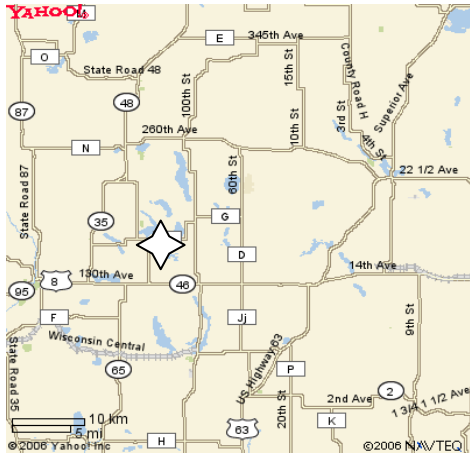

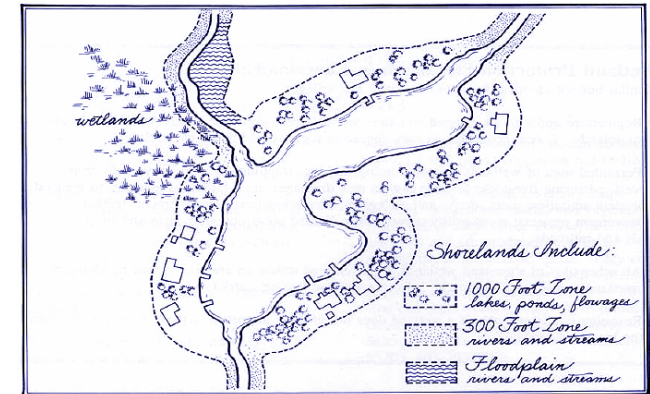
