This workshop series is designed to explain the process of comprehensive planning beginning with the formation of a plan commission through the implementation of the plan.

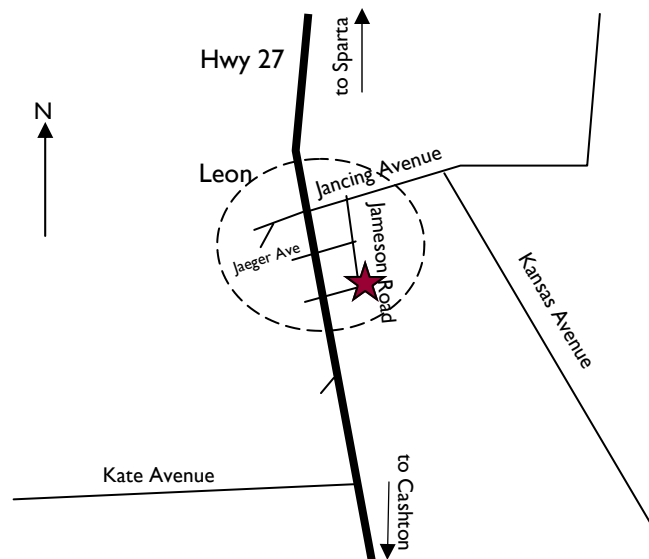
Who are these workshops for? This workshop series is targeted to plan commission members, elected officials, and the general public that is interested in comprehensive planning.

Tuesday, September 11:

Wisconsin Comprehensive Planning Law and the Plan Commission: Jim Schneider, J.D., Local Government Specialist, UWEX Local Government Center

This program begins with a brief overview of the WI Comprehensive Planning Law. It then covers the creation and responsibilities of a plan commission and ends with discussion of legal responsibilities of plan commissions under Wisconsin Open Meetings Law. This program will provide a great base of information for municipal plan commission members. **Registration Deadline: September 6**

Tuesday, October 2:

Public Participation: Rebecca Roberts, Land Use Specialist, UWEX Center for Land Use Education

This workshop will provide the basics of public participation as a key component in the development of your community's comprehensive plan. The workshop will address techniques for identifying and involving community members, methods to evaluate your participation process, and basic legal requirements for public participation. Example public participation plans will be shared and discussed. **Registration Deadline: September 27**

Tuesday, October 23:

Plan Elements - Part 1: Alicia Acken Cosgrove, AICP, Land Use Specialist, UW-River Falls and Amy Schanhofer, UWEX Monroe County

This workshop will focus on the following 4 elements of a comprehensive plan: Issues & Opportunities, Intergovernmental Cooperation, Utilities & Community Facilities, Housing. The workshop will address the format for the elements as well as the key questions to address within each element. Discussion will also include where to gather information for use in each element. **Registration Deadline: October 18**

Tuesday, November 6:

Plan Elements - Part 2: Alicia Acken Cosgrove, AICP, Land Use Specialist, UW-River Falls and Amy Schanhofer UWEX Monroe County

This workshop will focus on the following 4 elements of a comprehensive plan: Agricultural, Natural & Cultural Resources, Economic Development, Transportation, Land Use. The workshop will address the format for the elements as well as the key questions to address within each element. Discussion will also include where to gather information for use in each element. **Registration Deadline: November 1**

Tuesday, December 4:

Plan Implementation: Rebecca Roberts, Land Use Specialist, UW-Extension Center for Land Use Education

This workshop will discuss plan implementation as a key element of the comprehensive plan. The workshop will address common plan implementation tools such as zoning, subdivision regulations, and official mapping. It will also introduce participants to educational, voluntary and fiscal tools that may be used to implement the comprehensive plan. **Registration Deadline: November 29**
