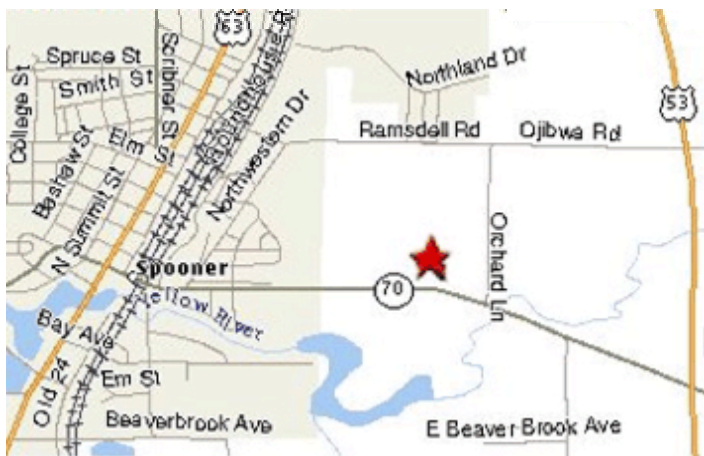


About the Program

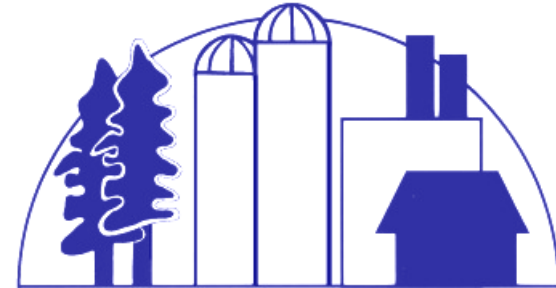
