

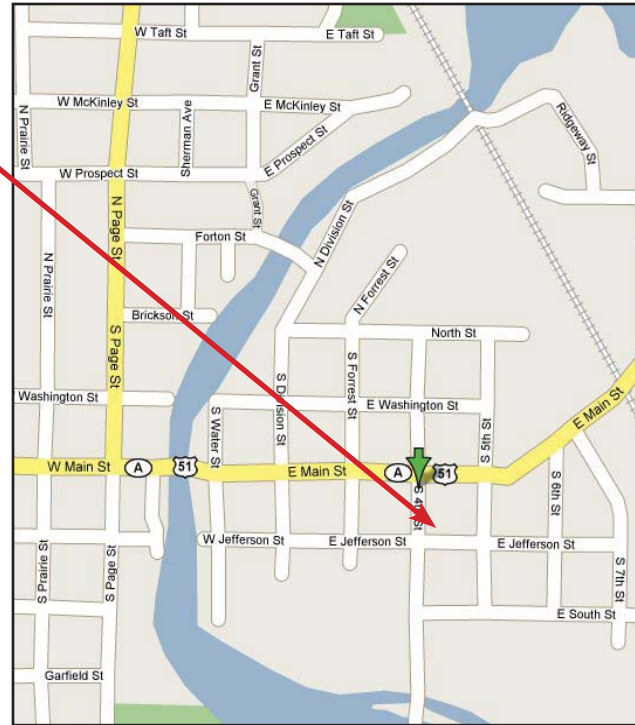
Location
