The teams selected will receive the following:

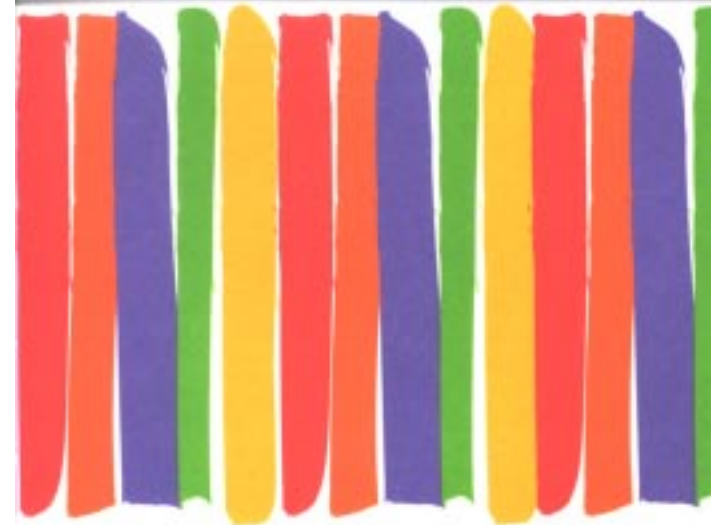
- 1) \$3500 total/team will be provided. We hope that you will bring at least three people. The key is to bring all of the individuals who will play a key role in helping coordinate your clinic. There will be no registration cost for those selected. Lodging, food and meeting space will cost approximately \$800/person. Remaining funds can be used to cover transportation to the workshop. Any costs over the \$3500/team will be the responsibility of individuals and teams attending.
- 2) A dynamic, high-quality workshop focused on your questions/needs and clinic plan. This workshop will cover:
 - ✓ The Leadership Clinic's participant-driven design principles,
 - ✓ Planning steps,
 - ✓ Customized clinic tools,
 - ✓ Unique and typical logistics planning, and networking with participants and resource people.

SELECTION PROCESS

We will choose and fund 6 teams, of 3-5 individuals each, that have plans underway to conduct a clinic in the next 2 years. Each team selected will be eligible to receive \$3,500 to attend the clinic. NEEAP will give special consideration to teams comprised of one or more individuals who have previously planned and/or attended one of the following clinics:

- NEEAP/NAAEE Spring Leadership Clinics
- EETAP Leadership Clinics
- USEPA Region 5 or 7 Conference
- 2002 or 2004 Midwest Leadership Clinic
- Columbia Basin Leadership Clinic
- State-level Leadership Clinics in Illinois, Ohio, Arizona, Oklahoma or Wisconsin

Teams that have a plan or have secured financial commitment for the implementation of their clinic will also have a competitive edge in being selected for the training.
