WHAT: Jurassic Sandstone cliffs meet recent lava flows from the Chain of Craters... Ancestral pueblo dwellings and rock art... Modern Native America... Homesteads... Wilderness... rich birds, plants & animals... Myriad trails and hikes.

WHERE: U.S. Bureau of Land Management Ranger Station, elevation 6700', 15 min. north to nearest town: Grants, New Mexico; 90 min. west of Albuquerque.

WHEN: 1 to 4 days per week, 8 hours per day; minimum 5 weeks. 18 years or older.

RESIDENCE: 2 back to back day's of service gets overnight use of bedroom. 4 days of service gets exclusive use of 2 bedroom efficiency, 7 days per week onsite with option to park & / or live in your RV onsite (no hookups or septic service provided).

DUTIES: Provide information in person and by phone. Learn & maintain knowledge of local area & landmarks for driving, camping, hiking, hunting, horseback,... Independently operate visitor center including cash register at small bookstore. Additional options include: public presentations in the field or at the station (your choice of relevant topics), trail work, wild land restoration, resource patrols & maintenance, professional 1 on 1 mentoring from professional rangers on land management; bird, rock & plant ID; local: archaeology, geology, flora & fauna, ecology, history & culture. Some food & fuel reimbursement available.
