I'm looking to fill the education coordinator position at Fort Smith NHS. The incumbent will work closely with the University of Arkansas at Fort Smith, public and private schools in west central Arkansas, and east central Oklahoma. Also, the park has purchased state of the art distance learning equipment that patiently awaits the arrival of the right person to begin broadcasting to schools and facilities around the world.

The park story spans approximately 80 years from 1817 to 1896 and focuses on actions and reactions of 19th century federal Indian policy.

The park is located in the historic district of Fort Smith, Arkansas at the confluence of the Arkansas and Poteau Rivers. With a population of 88,000 people, Fort Smith is the second largest city in Arkansas and the center of commerce for west central Arkansas and east central Oklahoma. It has an excellent public school system, The University of Arkansas Fort Smith, two major medical centers, an exceptional public library system and very professional police and fire departments. The city offers numerous shopping opportunities including one large mall, a wide variety of local and chain restaurants as well as clubs and other entertainment venues. The employment rate is below the state and national average. A wide variety of housing is available in Fort Smith and the surrounding communities; housing prices are also below the national average. The Ouachita and Ozark National Forests are located in nearby mountains to the north and south as well as lakes and rivers offer numerous and outdoor recreation opportunities.
