Passport Considerations

- New passport application processing is running 2 – 3 months
- Proof of passport in hand or timely application required by 1 December 2023
- Passports must be valid through
 15 December 2024

- Step One: CNR Pre-Application open now & closes @ noon on 30 October
- Step Two: OIE application will open by email invitation in early November and close 1 December

OIE application fee (\$100) <u>and</u> initial payment (\$500) due by 20 December







SFE Europe Program Fee Includes:

- Wisconsin resident tuition for 5 credits
- Lodging
- Airfare << on group itinerary
- Medical insurance << official program dates
- Nearly all meals
- Administrative fees

2023 program fee was \$7650



SFE Europe expenses <u>not included</u> in program fee:

- Passport fees
- Differential tuition charges
- Non-resident tuition (if applicable)
- MN reciprocity fee (if applicable)
- A few meals
- Spending money
- Individual travel

2023 estimated expenses were \$1300



Costs

- 2023 program fee payable to UWSP was \$7650
- Non-residents +\$250
- MN Reciprocity +\$326.55

 2023 estimated personal expenses were \$1300

We are aiming to keep the 2024 program fee within 5% of 2023 expenses... most significant variables are: (a) the strong U.S. Dollar (b) traveler count (c) airfare (d) inflation

Financial Aid

- Federal and state financial aid may be applied to all OIE Study Abroad programs
- The UWSP Office of Financial Aid will revise your award to include study abroad expenses if you submit the Study Abroad Revision Form to them
- Requesting an award adjustment <u>does not alter</u> your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)



Health & Wellness Considerations

- This program includes physically demanding activities
- Dietetic preferences and requirements may be difficult to accommodate in some locations
- Be prepared to source prescribed medications in sufficient quantity for the entire trip...this may require advance planning with your healthcare provider

- If you use accommodations, please coordinate a conversation with UWSP Disability Resource Center & OIE ... the goal here is to discuss accessibility considerations & supports available




