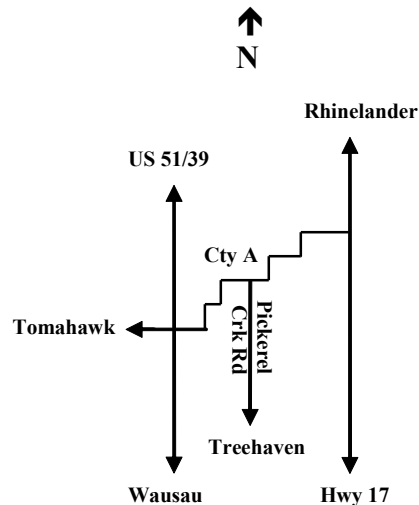

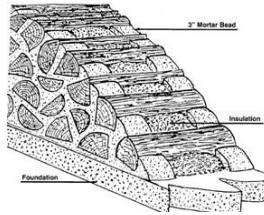

# Building a Cordwood Garden Shed



Our Cordwood workshop will be led by **Richard and Becky Flatau**, of Cordwood Construction Resources. They have 27 years experience in conducting cordwood workshops, providing individual/couple mortaring sessions, and training work crews on cordwood job sites. Richard and Becky most recently were involved in the building of an 1,800 sq. ft. “state-of-the-art” cordwood home on the White Earth Reservation in Naytahwaush, Minnesota. Having written three books on cordwood construction, they have been busy making presentations about “all things cordwood” to audiences all over the United States. In 2005 they hosted the highly successful Continental Cordwood Conference in Merrill, Wisconsin, complete with the building of a cordwood Maple Sugar Shack in Lincoln County.

This two day workshop is located at Treehaven near Tomahawk, WI. The project will be the cordwood infill of a framed tool shed with 12-inch cordwood log ends. This Wisconsin project will follow the garden shed plans that have been used successfully for so many varied applications.

The workshop is a mix of classroom and hands-on mortaring sessions.

Classroom sessions include general cordwood information, power point presentations and discussions of the of the various styles of cordwood houses/buildings, as well as the various species of wood (and how long to dry them), and different methods of insulation and framing. Frequent question and answer periods insure that participants come away with their inquiries answered. In addition, the Flataus also provide one hour of consultation via phone or email after the workshop.

Hands-on sessions include demonstrations by instructors and individually supervised hands-on practice. Best practices, the latest innovations and code compliance are all part of this workshop. Attention to detail assures that the students learn visually pleasing techniques, as well as structurally sound and energy-efficient construction methods.
