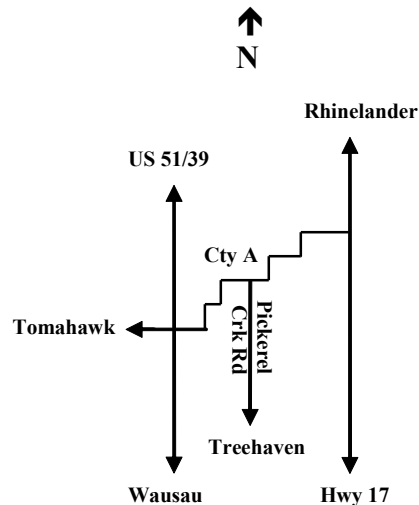

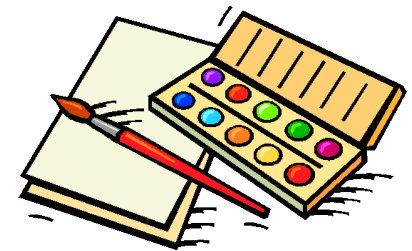

Learn about the materials and basic techniques that are the foundation of watercolor painting. This class is meant for those with no experience in the medium or the artist who finds watercolor frustrating and confusing. We will cover how to handle your equipment, produce flat, graded, and random washes, glazing, drypoint, masking, lifting, pouring, setting up for a painting and more.

Students need to provide watercolor paints, a few watercolor brushes, a palette and something in which to hold water. A big list with explanations is posted on our website, www.uwsp.edu/cnr/treehaven, or will be sent to you upon request. Good paper will be available at wholesale price from the instructor.

Ann Singsaas is an artist living, teaching and working in Stevens Point, WI. She majored in Art at Concordia College and received a BA in 1991, but continues her education in several visual mediums. Since 1998 she has been painting in watercolor and has won numerous awards for her botanical work.

Her classes are filled with demonstrations, and explanations of techniques and materials. She is always willing to answer individual questions or provide one on one help.
