Goal of the Day

Audience Overview

- Approximately 250 people will participate in the conference
- 85% of participants will be high school students in 9th-12th grade (14-18 yrs. old)
- 15% will be high school teachers
- Participants are from biology classes, environmental science classes, environmental clubs, etc.
- Participants are from all parts of Wisconsin – urban and rural, small and large schools, socio-economic diversity

- Nearly one hour of the conference is devoted to all participants exploring the exhibits that feature:
 - Professional exhibits
 - College recruitment exhibits
 - Careers speakers
 - High school and college student poster presentations
