This project addresses two needs identified by the Wattville School District . First, with the proper energy management/education training for teachers, administrators, and facilities personnel, an effective energy management policy can be properly outlined resulting in reduced energy consumption and lower utility bills. Second, an Energy Committee will be identified by the Wattville School Board consisting of an Energy Advisor, utility representative, school board member, District Administrator, Principal, Business Official, Curriculum Coordinator, Facilities Manager, and three teachers. Select members from the Energy Committee will form an Energy Action Plan Task Force (EAPTF) to develop an energy action plan for Wattville Middle School . This energy action plan will outline energy management policies, how energy education will be infused into the classroom curriculum, and how it will be integrated into school-wide energy initiatives, improving not only faculty and staff, but students' energy literacy. This holistic approach to educating the building occupants of Wattville Middle School will serve as a model for other schools in the Wattville School District .
