Admission Status: Graduate Study

Successful admission to Graduate Study requires admission to a specific graduate degree program. Many of our graduate degree programs employ additional application criteria such as letters of reference, personal interviews, standardized test scores, verification of certification, etc. This application, if approved, will be sent to the graduate program coordinator of the graduate program area you designate on the reverse side of this application. The graduate program coordinator will then contact you for any additional material needed to determine your acceptability into that program.

Admission Categories:

Graduate Special:

Graduate special students are not required to complete and submit an application for Graduate Study.

If you hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university or an advanced degree but you do not wish to be admitted to a graduate degree program, we will give you graduate special status. This category allows you to enroll in graduate-level courses and receive graduate credit for teacher's certification requirements or personal enrichment. There is no limit to the number of courses or credits you may take while in this category. If, as a graduate special student, you later wish to be admitted to a degree program, you must complete all of the formal requirements for admission required of those seeking admission to that graduate degree program.

The department offering a special degree program **MAY OR MAY NOT** accept graduate work you have completed prior to admission to a degree program, including course work you have completed with graduate special status. Furthermore, **NINE** graduate credits previously earned with graduate special status at UW-Stevens Point is the maximum that can be used to satisfy the requirements of a degree program.

Graduate Regular:

We grant this status when you have completed all of the following requirements for admission to Graduate Study:

1. A completed application to the Admissions Office requesting "graduate regular" status.
2. A check or money order for \$45.00 payable to "UW-Stevens Point" for the application as required by the Wisconsin Legislature.
3. **OFFICIAL** transcripts from all colleges (both undergraduate and graduate) you attended (**except UW-Stevens Point**). The transcript from the college from which you graduated must indicate that you earned a bachelor's degree.
**Transcripts must be sent in a sealed university envelope directly from that institution to the UW-Stevens Point Admissions Office, 102 Student Services Building, UWSP, Stevens Point, WI, 54481-3897. Transcripts "issued to the student" are not acceptable.
4. Admission to the specific degree program.
