Next stop is the Arenal Volcano where we will hike on the old lava flows, kayak in a crater lake and then relax in the hot springs. Our final stop is the cloud forest near San Ramon, where we may catch a glimpse of the illusive Resplendent Quetzal during one of our hikes.
