

AMSLC 2009 Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. Only the primary presenter should submit the Abstract.
2. Abstracts must be 150-200 words in length.
3. If applicable, include links within your abstract to documentation, formulas, images, music files, etc. in support of your submission. Note that some special characters (e.g., scientific symbols) cannot be properly processed by the form. If your abstract contains special characters or symbols, it is recommended that a link be provided to a location where your abstract can be viewed in its original form.
4. Submissions should follow these guidelines:
(A) Microsoft Word format, (II) Times New Roman, size 12. This formatting is necessary for publication in the conference program booklet, available at registration. Submissions must follow this format:
 - ⌚ Title of paper in capital letters.
 - ⌚ First name, middle initial, and last name of author and co-authors.
 - ⌚ Name of faculty mentor in parentheses.
 - ⌚ Department, institution, and institutional address where the research was conducted. At the end of the Abstract, place the author's home institution if different from the one above
