

# Winterim in Africa



## Tanzania

December 27, 2009 – January 18, 2010

**This 3-week journey includes a 10-day climb of Mt. Kilimanjaro followed by 10 days of safari focused on wildlife viewing at Tarangire & Manyara Nat'l Parks and in the Seregeti ecosystem (Ngorongoro Crater & Nduvu), meeting tribal people (Hadza bushmen) near Lake Wyasi & studying various forest and resource management issues in nearby areas.**

Approx. \$7,200 for 3 weeks based on 11 participants; includes round-trip airfare from Chicago, lodgings & meals, ground transportation, entrance fees, instructional fees (audit or UWSP undergrad credits), tours, & lectures. A \$250 non-refundable deposit is required to hold your spot. Contact UWSP Continuing Education for a registration form. **APPLY BY JUNE 1, 2009.** Applications after this date will be taken only if space is available.

**Open to adults of all ages.** All participants must stand up to the considerable physical rigors. Pre-tour orientation and post-tour follow up will be included.

Professor Schabel is a forest biologist with training in wildlife management. He lived in Tanzania for three years and has conducted 31 study-abroad programs, including six to East Africa. He received a medal from the Jagiellonian University in Poland, the UWSP service award, and a scholarship award from the College of Natural Resources. He recently wrote a book on the "Forest Insects of Tanzania."
