**LEADER:** George C.T. Kung, retired professor of Mathematics and Computer Science. Fluent in four dialects of Chinese. This will be his 7th time leading a group to China.

**COSTS:** Est. \$4,799 - \$4,999 double occupancy (based on 16 participants minimum). This includes round trip airfare from Chicago, all lodging, flights and transfers within China, group ground transportation, breakfast and most dinners, most entrance fees, guide fees and instructional costs. (Single supplement: \$620.) Visa fees extra.

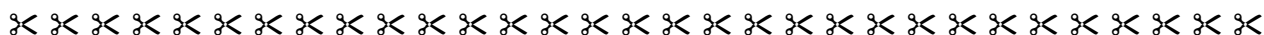
**REGISTRATION, DEPOSITS, AND PAYMENTS:** Formal registration should be accompanied by an initial payment of \$500 per person. Early registration is strongly advised—last time this trip filled very quickly! A payment schedule will be sent for the balance due. Up to sixteen weeks before departure, all fees except a \$200 cancellation fee will be refunded upon withdrawal. After that, airline and /or housing cancellation charges and visa fees may also be assessed. **Travel insurance is strongly recommended.**
