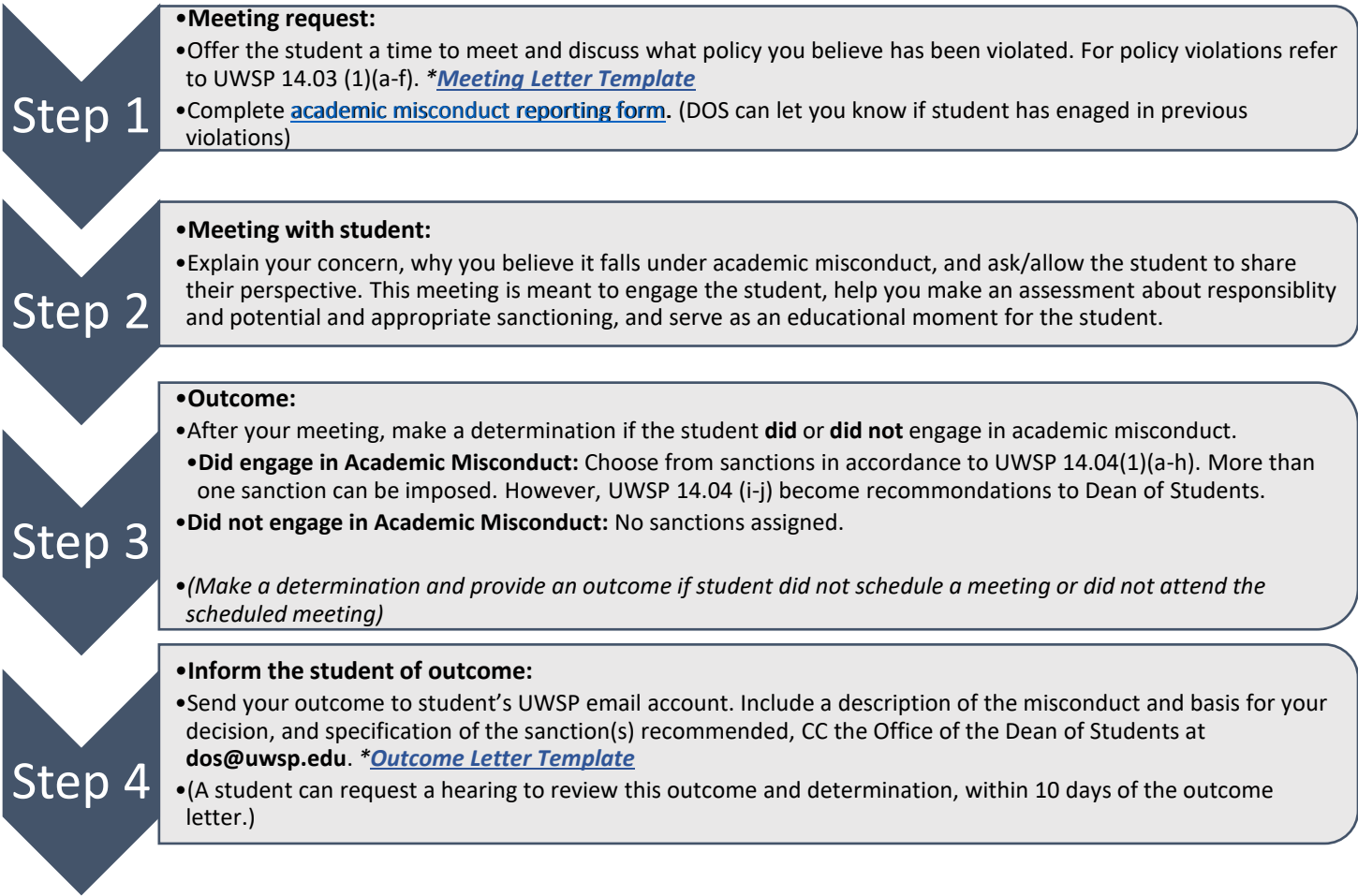


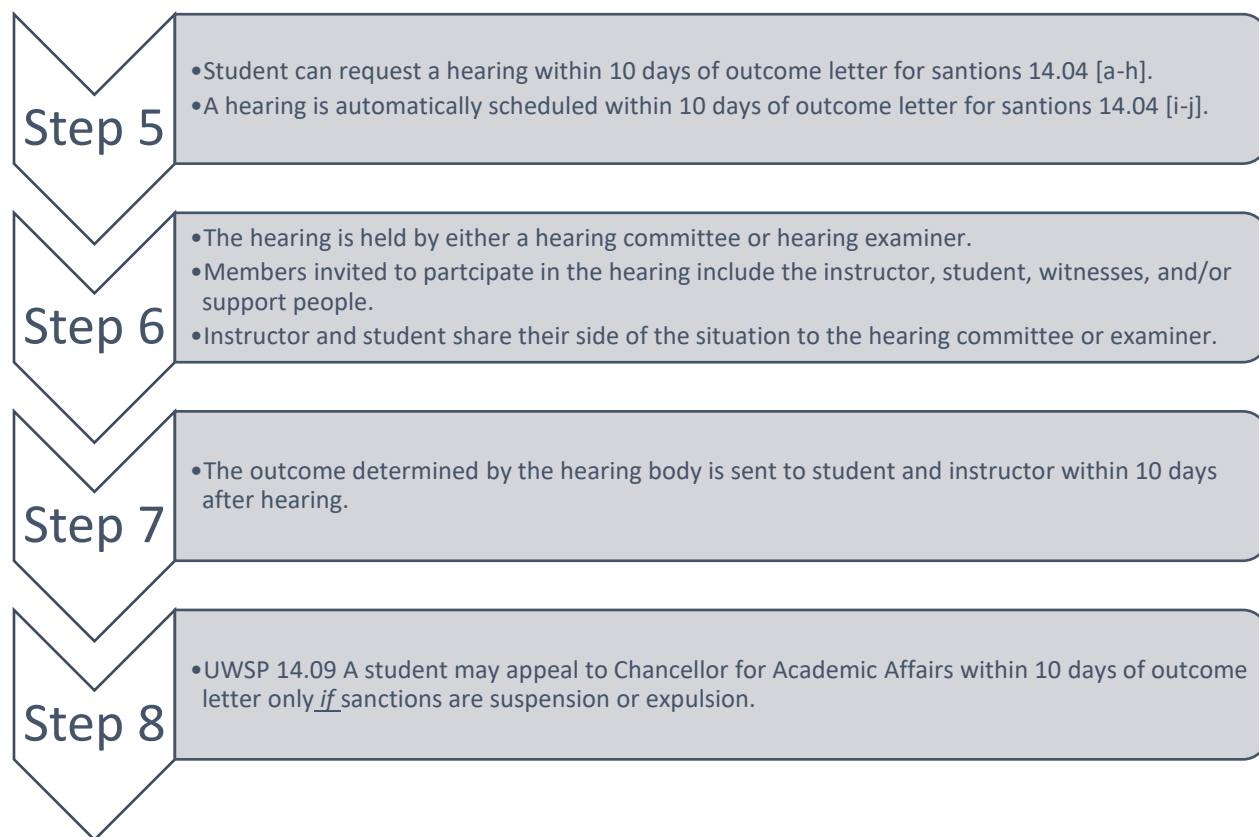

Academic Misconduct Violations	Sanctioning
<p style="text-align: center;">UWSP 14.03 (1)(a-f):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Seeks to claim credit for the work or efforts of another without authorization or citation; b. Uses unauthorized materials or fabricated data in any academic exercise; c. Forges or falsifies academic documents or records; d. Intentionally impedes or damages the academic work of others; e. Engages in conduct aimed at making false representation of a student’s academic performance; or f. Assists other students in any of these acts. 	<p style="text-align: center;">UWSP 14.04 sanctions a-h:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. An oral reprimand b. A written reprimand presented only to the student c. An assignment to repeat the work, to be graded on its merits d. A lower or failing grade on the particular assignment or test e. A lower grade in the course f. A failing grade in the course g. Removal of the student from the course in progress h. A written reprimand to be included in the student’s disciplinary file <p style="text-align: center;">-----</p> <p>Refer the case to the Dean of Students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *i. <i>Disciplinary Probation</i> *j. <i>Suspension or Expulsion from the University</i>

UWSP Ch. 14.08 Academic Misconduct Hearing Procedures

...Steps continued when a hearing is requested or required



Preparing for a hearing:

- **Prior to hearing:** Instructor will be asked for their written outcome and any evidence used to make determination in outcome.
- **During hearing:** Instructor and student have an opportunity to present their position on the case and ask and respond to questions.
- **During hearing:** Instructor and student may present witnesses, if applicable to the case.
