

SNAP for Children -

Fall of 2009

SNAP is offering an infant/toddler and preschool aquatic class in a special session for children between the ages of 6 months to 5 years. The young child's "special needs" in **SNAP** is to gain an initial positive water experience, to learn safety skills in and around water and to have fun. **All classes require parental involvement.** All classes will be led by an American Red Cross certified water safety instructor and may also serve as a practicum teaching site for physical education majors at the University. All classes will be held in the therapeutic pool in the Health Enhancement Center at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point. **Note:** *Class size is limited.*

"Infant & Toddler" Class (6-36 months)

Infants and parents will be exposed to water adjustment activities, be introduced to appropriate water safety skills and learn supported movements. Toddlers and parents will practice water adjustment activities, elementary propulsive aquatic movements and learn water safety skills. (therapeutic pool: limit 12 children/class)

CLASS OPTION #2

"Preschool" Class with Parent (3-5 years)

Preschoolers and parents will experience independent propulsive swimming movements, participate in advanced water adjustment activities, learn water safety skills and practice combined skills for basic swimming strokes in preparation for Level 1 Swimming Progression. (therapeutic pool: limit 12 children/class)
