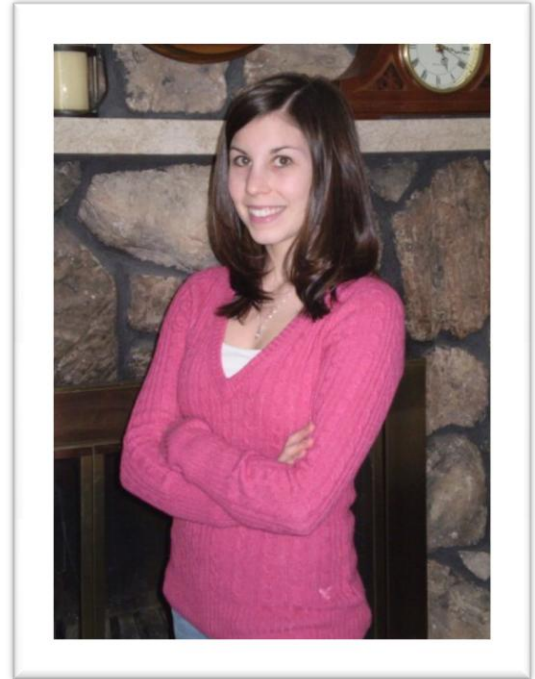


Dietetic Student Recognized as Outstanding Student by American Dietetic Association
