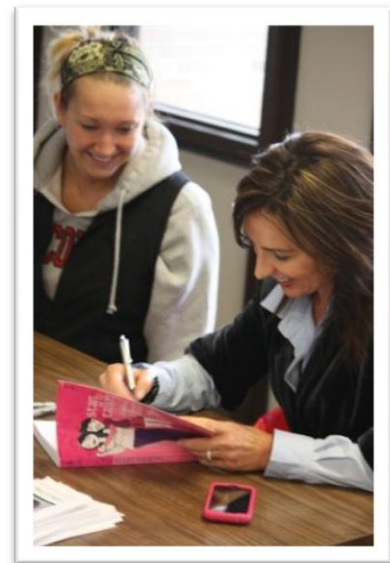


Sex Therapist, Mary Jo Rapini, teaches the Healthy American class about “Responsible Sexual Decisions.”
