## Disease Prevention Chronology in the United States

1700s-1800s-Modern vaccine development begins
1900-1950-U.S. mortality rates decline with improvements in living standards

1950-1970—Risk factors for chronic diseases begin to be identified and addressed


1970-1990-Smallpox eradicated but new diseases like HIV/AIDS take hold
1990s-2000s-Cancer rates peak and begin to fall; obesity rates rise
