What signatures are needed when **ADDING** a course?

Full semester course deadline – Sept. 2-14

- **Open course** and not Permission Required – No signatures needed.
- **Closed course** or Permission Required – Instructor or chair signature required.
- **After Sept. 14**, Adviser, Instructor, and Dept Chair signature required.

1st eight week course deadline – Sept. 2-8

- **Open course** and not Permission Required – No signatures needed.
- **Closed course** or Permission Required – Instructor or chair signature required.
- **After Sept. 8**, Adviser, Instructor, and Dept Chair signature required.

2nd eight week course deadline – Sept. 2-Oct. 29

- **Open course** and not Permission Required – No signatures needed.
- **Closed course** or Permission Required – Instructor or chair signature required.
- **After Oct. 29**, Adviser, Instructor, and Dept Chair signature required.

Course ADDS or DROPS can be processed on the web, or at the Registration and Records Office, through Sept.14, without signatures for full semester courses.

What signatures are needed when **DROPPING** a course?

Full semester course deadline

- **Sept. 2-14 – CLEAR DROP** (*course will not appear on transcript*) – No signatures needed.
- **Sept. 12-Nov. 6 – W-Drop** (*course appears on transcript*) – Adviser and Instructor signatures.
- **Drops not permitted after Nov. 6**

1st eight week course deadline

- **Sept. 2-8 – CLEAR DROP** (*course will not appear on transcript*) – No signatures needed.
- **Sept. 9-Oct. 2 – W-Drop** (*course appears on transcript*) – Adviser and Instructor signature.
- **Drops not permitted after Oct. 2**

2nd eight week course deadline

- **Sept. 2-Oct. 29 – CLEAR DROP** (*course will not appear on transcript*) – No signatures needed
- **Oct. 30-Nov. 25 – W-Drop** (*course appears on transcript*) – Adviser and Instructor signature.
- **Drops not permitted after Nov. 25**

***Dept. Chair** – signature required for Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Geology, & Physics.

****Chemistry Lab Clearance** – Required for all Chemistry Lab Courses. See the Chemistry Department (Science Building D129) for appropriate signature.

- PLEASE NOTE:** (1) Drop/Adds can be processed on the web (through September 14) or in-person at the Registration-Records Office.
- (2) Courses that are clear dropped won't show on a transcript but they will show on your schedule with the notation "clear drop" and the date.
 - (3) All Drop/Adds are effective the date they are received in the Registration-Records Office or processed on the web.
 - (4) You may be billed for "W" drop credits plus enrolled credits depending on the drop date. Click on the following link for additional information on refunds/fees: <http://www.uwsp.edu/admin/busaffairs/ar/deadlines.aspx>, or call Accounts Receivable (2118) for clarification.
 - (5) You are encouraged to consult with your adviser before adding and/or dropping courses.
 - (6) You are limited to a total of four (4) W drops after your first two semesters of enrollment at UWSP.
 - (7) It is your responsibility to keep the printed copy of your schedule from the drop/add transaction as a receipt.
 - (8) Drops/adds resulting in a credit overload require a signed or electronically authorized Credit Overload Authorization.
 - (9) Instructor, department chair and advisor signatures are invalid after 5 business days.
 - (10) Add/Drop deadlines will be appropriately prorated for sections meeting other than 8 or 16 weeks.
 - (11) Signature forgeries are a serious offense under the Academic Misconduct Guidelines.
 - (12) You cannot withdraw from school by completing Drop Forms for all your courses. Report to the Registration and Records Office, 101 SSC, for withdrawal instructions or click on the following link: <http://www.uwsp.edu/reg-rec/cancellations.aspx> .
