

Hyer Hall Sign-Up 2012-13

- Rooms in Hyer Hall are similar to those found on the north end of campus. They are equipped with one set of furniture (bed, dresser, desk, chair, wastebasket).
- Hyer Hall is designated as a quiet community.
- Hyer Hall residents are not required to participate in the meal plan program. Hyer residents are eligible to purchase any of the on-campus meal plans plus the "off-campus" plan. Meal plan options are outlined on the Dining Services' website: www.uwsp.edu/dining/pages/dining-plans.aspx
- There is a parking lot directly behind Hyer Hall. Residents are responsible for purchasing a permit through the UWSP Parking Services Office (www.uwsp.edu/parking).
- Hyer Hall is co-ed by room. Restroom facilities are designated: men on first and fourth floors; women on second and third.

Monday, 2/27 and on, 601 Division

Any (spring 2012) registered UWSP student (who will be 21 before 9/4/2012) may sign up from 8 a.m.—4:30 p.m.

This may be paid

- at time of application with a **check** (made payable to UWSP),

OR *in advance* via one of the following methods:

- **on-line** through your student account (only spring 2012 UWSP students can use this option)
- **in cash** (cash payments must be made at the Bursar's Office; bring your receipt with you)

Contract packets are available from the Residential Living Office, 601 Division. The office is open Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.—4:30 p.m.

You may apply any time after the date you become eligible to apply, but all assignments are on a first-come, first-assigned basis.
