Paper Science is a four-year (eight semesters) major. The option to work for one semester plus a summer is known as a "Co-op". Sophomore co-ops and junior internships are made available to interested students by paper companies and other paper industry related companies. These jobs provide students with valuable experience that will help prepare the student for employment after graduation.

Scholarships are provided by the UWSP Paper Science Foundation to qualified incoming freshmen who apply during their senior year of high school. Thereafter, scholarships are automatically given to students who have declared Paper Science as their major, and who obtain a grade point average (GPA) of 3.2 or above. In addition, the Merit Scholarship Program (see attached) offers additional incentives.

With scholarships from the UWSP Paper Science Foundation and monies earned from Co-op and Internship employment opportunities, our students realize a high level of potential financial support toward the Paper Science major's college education at UWSP.
