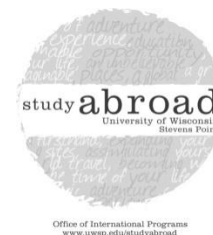

PASSPORT PHOTO SESSIONS

After being accepted into your program, you must then return the following number of passport photos to the International Programs office: Australia (0), Britain (1) & Britain Interns (2), Liverpool (1), Poland (6), Ireland (3), Mexico (1), France (6), Spain (6), Hungary (6), New Zealand (1). **One passport photo is required for students participating in short-term programs in Europe.** If you are applying for your passport, one (1) passport photo is required with your passport application.

Students unable to attend a scheduled passport photo session can arrange a time with the photographer by e-mailing dmoore@uwsp.edu or stopping in at the Photography Services office, 119 Delzell Hall. **If passport photos are taken at UWSP Photo Services, the charge for this service will be billed directly to International Programs and applied to the students' account.** Students unable to have photos taken at UWSP must make arrangements on their own.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR STUDENTS RECEIVING FINANCIAL AID!

- Apply for or renew your financial aid application (FAFSA) for the 2012-2013 academic year.
- The UWSP Financial Aid Office will email you your Letter of Offer for 2012-2013. Please "accept" your award and act on all action items.
- You then should ask the UWSP Financial Aid Office to 'revise' your award letter to include your specific expenses.
- Students from other schools should contact their home campus Financial Aid office to begin the process of a Consortium Agreement. Once the Consortium Agreement is sent to the UWSP Financial Aid Office and completed and returned to your home campus, you should receive a "Revised Award Letter."
