

Guidelines for developing a show for STV

STV is always looking for more shows to air on Channel 10. We strive to air shows which are of highest quality. In hopes of helping students gain experience in television, ensure that they have the content that is appropriate for the audience of our station, and comply with the regulations of being a public access Television Station, the STV executive staff has created some guidelines to help in the preparation of these shows.

1. Swearing is to be avoided as much as possible in the production of a show. . If a word needs to be censored, it does not need to be in the show.
2. When you are producing a new show specifically for STV, please submit a proposal as to what the show will be about, and what the content of that show will be to the Content Director. This will allow the Content Director to give suggestions on content, and to make sure that the show is suitable for STV.
3. If you would like STV to air a production which has already been completed, you will need to submit the project to the Content Director of STV for review.
4. Equipment is available only for projects made for STV. Any other use of STV equipment is not allowed. This equipment should be checked out through a member of the STV executive staff.
5. STV executive staff members would like to help in any way possible with the pre-production, production, or post-production of a show made for STV. Please be aware that executive staff members are all students at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, and thus they also have scholastic commitments which they need to take care of also.
6. All final decisions on whether to air a show or not will be made by the Content Director and the STV Executive Staff.
