Enrichment courses are scheduled during non-class hours and may be taken in conjunction with Unit and Supplemental courses.

Every Child Canl® (ECC) is an introduction to Dr. Suzuki's philosophy and its application to Suzuki education. For parents, teachers, prospective teachers and others, this six-hour course provides an inspiring, in-depth look at the Suzuki approach to teaching and learning. For teachers, ECC serves as the required first course in the Suzuki Association of the Americas Teacher Development Program.

Book 1 Teacher Training Courses include 28 hours of instruction plus 15 hours of observation. Course participatns must take Every Child Can! prior to beginning Book 1 and complete the SAA Audition process (deadline July 1). You also must be an active SAA member and be 18 or older and a high school graduate or equivalent. Prepare for the course by memorizing the Book 1 repertoire and be conversant with the philosophical principles in *Nurtured By Love* and Every Child Can! Detailed information on the Audition process may be found on the SAA website (www.suzukiassociation.org).

**Book 2 and above** Teacher Training Courses include 15 hours of instruction plus 8 hours of observation. All course participants are asked to prepare the repertoire to be studied to the point of fluent performance. Memorization is not required but it is recommended. Participants should read, or re-read, Dr. Suzuki's *Nurtured By Love* and *Ability Development from Age Zero*. Unites 1-3 must be taken and registered for in order.

**Supplemental Teacher Training Courses** include 15 hours of instruction, but no hours of observation are required.

**Enrichment Teacher Training Courses** include 10 hours of instruction and require no hours of observation. Enrichement course classes are scheduled during non-class hours and may be taken in conjunction with Unit and Supplemental courses. Teaching Strategies is structured in a similar way and can be taken in conjunction with a Unit or Supplemental Course. Strategies courses do require some additional time

Scholarship is available. Forms can be found on our website.

For all training courses, 100% attendance is mandatory. All participants will be performing in class. String, harp, and flute participants are expected to provide their own instruments. No videotaping of classes is allowed.

**Registration deadline:** After May 31, late fees will apply, however we will accept late registrations as long as space is available. Please use the SAA website to check Teacher Training class sizes.

**\$40 tuition rebate** will be given to teachers who sign up for two Suzuki core units. (SECE, Practicum, Enrichment and Supplemental courses not included.)

**\$25 tuition rebate** will be given to teachers who sign up for a Unit or Supplemental course and a 10-hour Enrichment course in the same week.

**Course Cancellations:** ASI will cancel teacher training courses on June 27 if enrollment is insufficient. Please <u>register as early as possible</u> so we do not cancel a course you would like to enroll in. If a course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, you will be notified by June 29. If you choose to purchase a non-refundable plane ticket before June 29, ASI will not be liable. Please use the SAA website to check Teacher Training class enrollments.

The American Suzuki Foundation is offering Short-Term Teacher Training Scholarships to honor Dr. Suzuki. Scholarships will be applied to your ASI account.
