SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

1. Associate degree graduates must have earned a minimum grade point average of 2.75. An ineligible candidate may appeal for consideration through the Head, School of Health Care Professions.
2. The UWSP required course, CLS 105 Evolution of Health Care and Health Care Professions (3 credits) and HS 105 Survey of Common Diseases will be waived.
3. MSTC courses 10806177 Anatomy and Physiology (4 credits) will be accepted in lieu of Biology 285: Human Physiology, 10809196 Intro to Sociology (3) will be accepted in lieu of Sociology 101, and 10809198 Intro to Psych (3) will be accepted in lieu of Psych 110, if a grade of C or better has been earned. An ineligible candidate may appeal for consideration through the Head, School of Health Care Professions.
4. The acceptance of credits applies only to this Program-to-Program Articulation.
5. For acceptance of equivalent courses, MSTC courses must have been completed within the last 5 years. Beyond this period of time, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
6. This agreement is subject to review if either MSTC or UWSP undergoes curriculum revision **OR** within five years of the origination date of this agreement, whichever occurs earlier.
