

American Suzuki Institute Teen Dorm Code of Conduct

1. Attend all of your classes. In case of illness notify the counselor on the floor prior to missing any classes. In case of emergency call the Suzuki office at x3033.
2. Attendance is required at all 4:00 recitals, evening recitals and teen dorm activities unless prior arrangements are made for practicing or resting in your room.
3. All Teen Dorm residents must be on their floor in the residence hall by 9:00 p.m. The only exception to this rule is if you are with a counselor or the Director or ASI Coordinator.
4. Teen Dorm Residence Hall floors are off-limits to the opposite sex. Anyone who breaks this rule will be removed from the Teen Dorm. In addition, Teen Dorm residents may not enter the room of a member of the opposite sex anywhere on campus unless there is a parent or other responsible adult present in the room at the same time.
5. For your own security, Teen Dorm residents will not be permitted to have guests in the residence halls who are not affiliated with the American Suzuki Institute.
6. Teen Dorm residents are not permitted to smoke during the Institute, on or off campus. Drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited (prescription drugs will be managed by a trained counselor). Anyone violating this rule will be removed from ASI.
7. Aggressive behavior such as (but not limited to) bullying will not be tolerated. This includes physical aggression and cyber-bullying. These behaviors are grounds for dismissal from the Teen Dorm and ASI
8. To go off campus you must be signed out by an approved guardian and an ASI counselor. Your counselor has the sign-out sheet. You must be signed back into campus by the counselor and the approved guardian. Riding in anyone's car while signed into the Teen Dorm is prohibited. The only exception is a medical emergency and if you are accompanied by the Director or Coordinator.
9. Teens with a motor vehicle on campus are strictly prohibited from using said vehicle for any reason, at any time. This restriction begins when the teen checks into the Teen Dorm on Sunday, and ends only when the teen has checked out of the Teen Dorm on Saturday. No exceptions.
10. The American Suzuki Institute reserves the right to remove from the Teen Dorm and/or ASI any student who fails to behave in an appropriate manner. General behavioral expectations will be discussed at the required Teen Dorm meeting.
