If you are applying for Financial Aid, your award will align with your credit load. Your aid award will be adjusted if you fall below the credit requirements for each term. You must be enrolled at least half-time to be considered for Federal Work-Study and the Unsubsidized Direct Loan. Graduate requirements—

- **Fall or Spring Terms:** 9+ credits full-time per term; 7-8 credits three-quarter-time per term; 5 credits half-time per term.
- **Summer Term:** 5+ credits full-time; 4 credits three-quarter-time; 3 credits half-time.
