

# **Test Scoring Changes for Fall**

xam scoring service at CITL, which has been on hold during the pandemic, returns this Fall semester with some changes. The overall process won't change for instructors, but there are important changes to note.

- The test scoring sheet is changing. Effective immediately, the old green sheets that have been used in the past will not work. You should discard any of these forms. We will not be able to process the forms that we've used in the past. Shortly, we'll have new forms available for purchase from Central Stores, but for now, you'll need to get them from CITL. We are reluctant to print these in bulk until we've had a chance to test them in real-world applications.
- **Test Scores On The Web is being decommissioned.** We've seen inaccuracies in the service, and don't have resources to update the service. We're working to include a canvas import file with instructor results packets to make it easier for instructors to bring results into their Canvas gradebooks.
- **Available reports are changing.** Initially, we'll include a standard set of reports. Next semester, we'll give you the option to select the ones that you want.
- **Results will no longer be emailed to instructors.** Instead, we're creating shared OneDrive folders that will allow you to access your result reports securely.

#### Seating Chart and Roll Call Tools

For the Fall 2021 semester, all faculty and instructors are asked to utilize a seating chart within Canvas for each of their courses. This will facilitate contact tracing if/when positive COVID-19 cases occur. We have created a video to explain how to set up the Roll Call and Seating Chart tools in Canvas. Note that taking attendance is less important for contact tracing than simply utilizing a seating chart, especially in larger classes where daily attendance may be time-consuming.

A new installation must be completed by CITL staff. Honorlock installations copied from previous courses will not function properly.
