



Our research shows a knowledge and behavior gap...


Badger Poll 2009:

Draining and transporting live fish have lowest reported KNOWLEDGE



Watercraft inspection surveys:

Draining boats and livewells has lowest reported COMPLIANCE



There is confusion surrounding the laws and logic... 2012 Boater/Angler focus groups


