Join us for the 10th annual fly fishing rendezvous at the Rose Farm on the Waupaca River. Long-time BOW instructor, the “Queen Mother” of fly fishing, Nancy Rose, along with a cadre of fishing gurus will provide a guided experience on this class-A trout stream and at local fishing hot spots.

WORKSHOP SCHEDULE

Our program begins at 7:00 on Friday evening, June 1, with a meet-and-greet social hour on the rustic farmhouse porch overlooking the river. Coffee, desserts and camaraderie will be served.

The instructional sessions begin Saturday, June 2, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. with hands-on lessons in equipment, knot tying, and casting. There will be one instructor for every two participants so individualized coaching will help you learn the graceful art of fly casting.

After a light lunch, participants will head out to the water to relax, learn, and enjoy fly fishing. Patient and experienced guides will make this a rewarding experience, even if the fish aren't biting! You will learn casting techniques, reading the water, proper handling and release of fish, fly tying and more.

We'll take a break from fishing for a hearty dinner at the farm. Home-cooked meals are served buffet style and beverages and desserts are included.

Fishing can, at times, be the best at night. Participants will have the option of fishing into the evening hours. With luck, we'll get into a hatch of insects to entice the hungry trout on the river.

Hospitality, scenery, excellent food, and camaraderie will round out this one-of-a-kind fishing adventure. The formal workshop concludes on Saturday night, but we'll have suggestions for optional activities on Sunday for those staying in the area on Saturday night.

This is Wisconsin's “Free Fishing” weekend so a license or trout stamp will *not* be required. Fly rods, reels, and waders are provided.

WORKSHOP NOTES

Workshop registration fee: \$225. Includes desserts and coffee on Friday June 1, 2018, lunch and dinner on Saturday, June 2, 2018, casting instruction, guided fishing, river access via the Rose Farm property.

Cancellation policy: A \$100 processing fee will be assessed to all cancelled registrations. Registrants who do not cancel by Friday, May 12, 2018, will be assessed the full program fee. You may send a substitute.

Lodging: Is not included but we will send a list of lodging and camping options with your confirmation letter.
