Shoreland Zoning

Tuesday, March 16, 2021, 10-11 am

Join us for a photo tour of waterfront properties! We know that waterfront property values depend on clear water, and that the fisheries in a lake are also an indicator of water quality and habitat. We'll take a look at a range of waterfront properties, discuss how they are likely to impact the lake or river, and whether they meet state shoreland standards.

Subdivision Regulations

Thursday, April 8, 2021, 1-2 pm

Subdivision regulations provide a legal process for dividing and recording land. In this session, we'll review state requirements for subdivisions, options for local land division ordinances, and the role of local government officials in reviewing plats and certified survey maps.

Zoning Fundamentals

Thursday, April 29, 2021, 10-11 am

We will discuss what zoning is and why most Wisconsin communities have adopted it. We'll explore the role of different local government bodies in adopting, amending and administering zoning.

Meeting and Hearing Conduct

Tuesday, May 18, 2021, 1-2 pm

In this session, we'll look at meeting vignettes to learn how to conduct more effective meetings and hearings. We'll discuss the difference between legislative and quasi-judicial decision-makers and the importance of creating an effective record of planning and zoning decisions.
