



Are you interested in fire? Do you want the opportunity for hands-on experience in prescribed burning and wildland firefighting? Consider registering for the Spring Wildland Firefighter Course hosted by the WI DNR and the UWSP Fire Crew. By taking this twoweekend course you'll receive the basic certifications necessary to qualify as a Firefighter Type 2 (FFT2).
