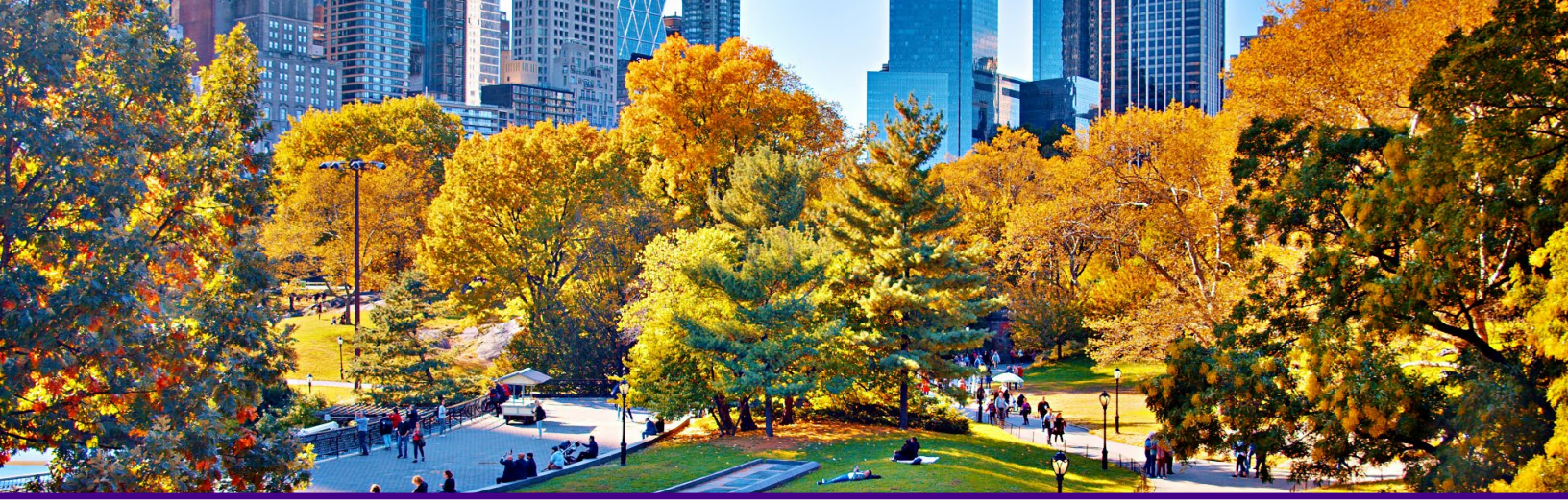

***Since we make financial commitments in advance, no refunds will be issued for cancellations less than 90 days prior to the trip. Cancellations received more than 90 days before the trip will receive a full refund minus \$450. However, you may send a substitute in your place. Price includes:

- Round-trip flight (Milwaukee/New York)
- Coach transfers between airport and hotel/UWSP
- Lodging centrally located near Times Square/Broadway and subway lines (four nights double occupancy)
- Full breakfasts at the M Social Hotel
- Four Broadway Shows
- Private Coach City Tour
- Walks to Central Park and over the Brooklyn Bridge (weather dependent)
- Two Trip Leaders throughout tour
- Orientation meeting approximately two months before the trip

The price of the trip is \$3,900 based on double occupancy. Your deposit will be applied to the total trip cost. If you require a single room, the cost is an additional \$1,375. A non-refundable deposit of \$450 per person is required with your registration as we must book nonrefundable airfare, hotel rooms, and theatre tickets. Out-of-state travelers who make their own flight arrangements will receive a \$400 discount (initial \$450 deposit is still required).
