The Bachelor of Music in Music Education program

offers Wisconsin teacher certification in music education. Successful candidates in the program earn a Bachelor of Music degree and a Wisconsin teaching license in one or more of the music education certification areas (choral, general, and instrumental). Full admission to this program is through an application and interview process normally completed during a student's sophomore year.

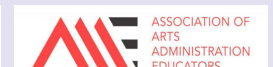
