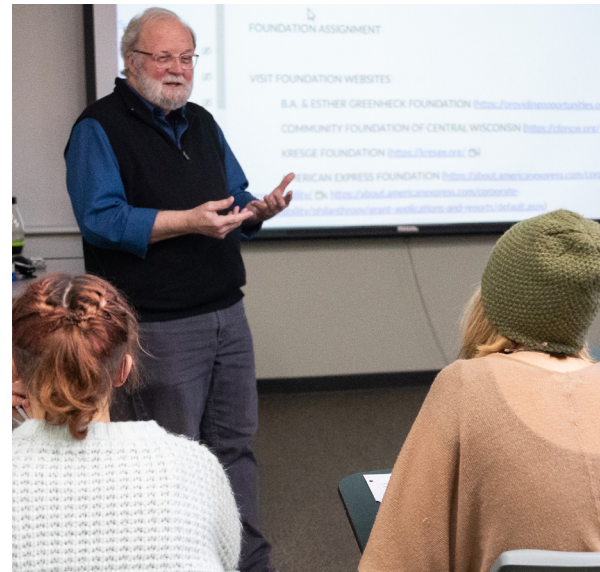

Combines skills in business, communication and the arts to promote all facets of the arts. Arts managers are responsible for financing and marketing, developing programs, managing facilities, writing grants, and managing personnel to support arts and arts agencies.

## The Arts, Media, and Entertainment Management program,

which was established in 1988, is the oldest undergraduate program of its kind in the state. This interdisciplinary major consists of courses in arts management, business, communication and the arts, two internships, and a semester-long externship. With this major you will explore the interrelationship of the arts, communication skills, and business constraints that apply to the financing, producing, promoting, and marketing of the arts. In addition to artistic and cultural values, you will learn practical skills of organizational development, public relations, marketing, and leadership in the arts.
