

Summer Deep Cleaning Prior to Return and Touch Points

Prior to students returning to the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point campus in the fall of 2020, all academic, administrative and centers buildings will have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected during the summer of 2020.

- ***Custodial staff has routinely disinfected high-touch surfaces (e.g. tables, doorknobs, light switches, handrails, door push bars, water fountains, elevator buttons) in all public areas across campus. This work will continue to be a point of emphasis during the school semester.***

Services Provided in Classrooms and Lecture Halls

- Custodial staff will be disinfecting classrooms and lecture halls twice per day to include an electrostatic delivery method.
- The primary emphasis for custodial staff will be to clean and disinfect surfaces and objects in high-usage spaces with the expectation that rooms not in use will be taken off-line.

Services Provided in Restrooms and Locker Rooms (including Allen Center)

- Custodial staff will be disinfecting, damp mopping, and restocking restrooms & locker rooms 2 times per day.
- High traffic restrooms and locker rooms will be disinfected using an electrostatic delivery method as needed.

Services Provided in Personal, Departmental, Dean's Offices and Conference Rooms

- Custodial staff will be cleaning and disinfecting offices 1 time per week.
- This work will be shifted to after 4pm, when most staff have vacated the buildings
- If garbage and recycling need to be emptied more than once per week, office occupants should take the items to the public trash and recycling areas on each floor of the building.
- Central Stores will have kits available to departments and staff for self-cleaning personal office areas. (Part Code: 1108210)

Services Provided in Public Computer Labs

- Custodial staff will wipe down (disinfect) computer workstations and keyboards 1 time per day (users will be instructed to disinfect workstation prior to use, disinfecting products provided).
- In addition, custodial staff will disinfect using an electrostatic delivery method 1 time per week.

Services Provided in Research Labs

- Custodial staff will follow strict room authorization guidelines presented in the form of signage posted in each lab or research area entryway. As in the past, the Custodial Work Unit will work with the Chemistry and Biology departments to address any area of concern.

Services Provided in Dreyfus University Center

- Custodial staff will disinfect 1 time per day in conference rooms, large meeting rooms and public areas.
- Custodial staff will disinfect restrooms 2 times per day.
- Custodial staff will be disinfecting classrooms twice per day (to include an electrostatic delivery method).
- Custodial staff will disinfect high-usage spaces using an electrostatic delivery method 1 time per day (including restrooms).

Services Provided in DeBot Dining Center

- Custodial staff will be disinfecting 1 time per day and wiping frequently touched surfaces between the 3 specific mealtimes 3 times per day.
- Custodial staff will be disinfecting, damp mopping, and restocking the DeBot locker rooms 3 times per day (to include 1 electrostatic spray per day).
- Custodial staff will routinely clean all other areas.

Services Provided in Residential Life Buildings

- Custodial staff will be disinfecting 1 time per day in public areas, restrooms, shower rooms, lobbies, and elevators.
- Custodial staff will disinfect restrooms using an electrostatic delivery method 1 time per day.
- Custodial staff will disinfect touch points in high-usage spaces 3 times per day (e.g. lobby tables, doorknobs, light switches, stairwell handrails, door push bars, water fountains, elevator buttons).
- Kitchens in Residential Life buildings will be disinfected 1 time per day.
- Kitchens will be locked. Students can enter with a keycard allowing access to be monitored.
- Cleaning kits and instructions for self-cleaning will be provided in each kitchen by custodial.

Confirmed Case Covid-19 Response

- If a person is confirmed to have a case of Covid-19, Facility Services will clean and disinfect any impacted areas following guidance created by UWSP's Pandemic Response Team.
